

Local Rules - The Ver Course

OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 18)

Beyond all boundaries of the course. The carpark, clubhouse patio and gardens. The Par 3 course, driving range and practice area. The reservoir between 8th and 10th holes.

When playing 6th beyond white posts to left of fairway.

When playing 17th beyond white posts to left of fairway.

When playing 18th beyond white posts to left of fairway.

YELLOW PENALTY AREAS (Rule 17)

All areas surrounded by yellow posts whether or not containing water.

RED PENALTY AREAS (Rule 17)

All areas marked with red posts whether or not containing water, except for NO PLAY ZONES.

PROTECTION OF YOUNG TREES (Rule 16)

Any tree that is staked. If such a tree interferes with a player's stance or the area of intended swing the ball must be lifted, without penalty and dropped within one

club length of the nearest point of relief that can be obtained from the tree.

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 16)

Telegraph poles and support wires. All manmade pathways.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Rule 16)

Any area defined with white lines is ground under repair. Tractor ruts. A teeing area other than that of the hole in play. All temporary greens and any green other than the hole being played. Relief must be taken. (The ball must be dropped off the green at the nearest point of relief).

STONES IN BUNKERS

Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions. Rule 16 applies.

OVERHEAD CABLES

A ball striking an overhead cable must be replayed. Rule 14.6 applies.

FIXED SPRINKLER HEADS

All fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference can be obtained.

IN THE EVENT OF THUNDER AND LIGHTNING

It is the player's responsibility to leave the course. No klaxon will be sounded.

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE

Matchplay – Loss of hole Strokeplay – Two strokes

Please repair pitchmarks, replace divots and rake bunkers after use. Bunker rakes to be left in the sand with the head of the rake pointing towards the green.
