## COMPETITION RULES

### 49. ELIGIBILITY

To enter a Ladies Section competition, you must be a member of Redbourn Golf Club and hold an official WHS handicap index.

You should also pay some money into the Ladies Section bank account, to be held in the HowDidIDo Competition account, so that you can sign in to competitions. When you sign in, a payment of (normally) £2 will be deducted from your Competition account, to pay for prizes, trophy engraving etc.

To win an individual trophy competition you must have played 3 competitions in the previous 12 months with the Redbourn Ladies Section where scores qualify for handicap purposes. This rule does not apply to team trophy competitions. (May 2021 Committee Meeting). To win a competition, you must have a current handicap, which is defined as recording 8 qualifying rounds (some of these may be casual rounds) in the 12 months before the competition. (November 2022 Committee). Exceptions can be made by the Committee for new members who have not been playing for 12 months, and those who have had long periods of not playing golf eg due to injury or illness.

7 day lady members may play in ladies section competitions and medals on a Wednesday and a Sunday. 5 day lady members can play in ladies section competitions and medals on Sunday but they must pay the green fee. Where competitions are joint Wednesday and Sunday the 7 day member must nominate which day she will be entering the competition. If a 7 day member elects to play on Sunday, but the game is cancelled, then she can enter the Wednesday competition. To find out which these are, refer to the Competitions Book, a copy of which is on the members section of the website.

Junior girls are eligible to join in many of the Ladies Section competitions. These include all medals and Stablefords played within the Ladies Section, including the following: Charity Bowl, Eric Russell, Daphne Tant, Club Championships, Lady Captain v Vice Captain Challenge, Charity Bowl and Deudon Charity Chrystal.

At the request of the Junior organizer, and in order to fall in line with competitions entered by boys, junior girls will pay the normal competition fee, but are not allowed to win trophies or prize *money*. (Updated November 2015 following discussion with Junior organizer and Competitions Committee).

### 50. ENTERING COMPETITIONS

Ladies section competitions are held on Wednesdays and Sundays. Reserved tee times are 10.04 – 11.40 on Wednesday, and 10.04 – 10.28 on Sunday. Upcoming competitions are available to view and book onto via How Did I Do and the PSI terminal in the clubhouse 4-8 weeks ahead. Wednesday competitions are closed for entry 9 days ahead, and Sunday competitions 7 days ahead. When the competition is closed all but 2 (on a Wednesday) unused reserved tee times are given back to the club.

With a few exceptions, all competitions are drawn, so a start sheet showing playing partners and tee times will be emailed to players a week ahead of a competition.

Players who need to withdraw from a competition after the draw has been made must notify the duty officer whose name will be shown on the start/draw sheet. In the event of a team competition playing partners must also be notified.

## **51. ON THE DAY OF THE COMPETITION**

Players must arrive 30 minutes before allocated tee time and check in with the duty officer.

Players must ALSO sign in to all competitions via the PSI or the 'Todays Golf' tab on the How Did I Do (HDID) app prior to play. Failure to sign in will result in disqualification.

The competition fee is normally £2 and is paid at the point of signing in to competitions from the player's HDIDcompetition account held by the ladies' section.

## **52. SCORECARDS**

Scorecards must be completed with the competition name, date /tee time, players name, the markers name, membership number, handicap index, course handicap and playing handicap.

(Players need to be aware of any changes in handicap index which will affect their course or playing handicaps. This will be shown when signing into a competition).

It is the players' responsibility to ensure the correct gross score has been recorded at each hole and the card is signed by the marker and the player.

## **53. SUBMITTING A SCORE**

Unless otherwise advised, players are responsible for entering their competition scores electronically via the PSI system or the HDID app. This should be undertaken immediately after the round and the scorecard handed to a member of the ladies committee. Medal competitions will be closed at end of the day. Other competitions will be closed when the final group on the draw sheet has completed the round and entered scores. No score entry is permitted after the competition is closed.

In a stroke play competition if a player does not complete a hole this can be recorded with a zero and will result in Nil Return for competition purposes.

If a player does not complete a full round, scores should be entered for those holes played. This will also result in a Nil Return for competition purposes.

## **54. HANDICAP LIMITS**

Where upper handicap limits are imposed on any competition this shall be set at 36 and based on the WHS handicap index. The corresponding course/playing handicaps for Redbourn would be used. (*Updated May 2021 committee meeting*)

## **55. GENERAL RULES**

A minimum number of 6 players or 3 teams are needed to proceed with a trophy competition when played on a Sunday or Wednesday. In the case of a joint competition (played on Wednesday AND Sunday) a minimum number of 6 individual competitors or 3 teams over the two days are required to make this valid. (Committee decision 14 Aug 2019).

Ties are decided on countback of the last 9, 6, 3 then 1 holes.

Medal competitions are played in handicap order within the Ladies Section on Wednesdays and Sundays from March to October. Medal competitions on Wednesday and Sunday can be played outside the reserved tee times. Completed scorecards should be handed in to the ladies committee via the Pro Shop. Other competitions can be played before reserved tee times on Sundays. The Sunday duty officer needs to be notified and cards handed in via the Pro Shop.

Other competitions are drawn in 3 balls or 4 balls with mixed handicap indexes. The order of play is determined by the draw officer for each day who will try to ensure fair play and rotation in the field.

All competitions are played in line with England Golf playing handicap mandatory allowances

There are no restrictions on the use of buggies for competitions played over one round in a single day.

## **56. NON-QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS**

Non-qualifying competitions do not count toward handicap adjustment. All games that are not individual, or not played over 18 holes, or Matchplay, are non-qualifiers. eg team games, restricted clubs, 13 holes, or more than 2 temporary greens in play.

## **57. NOT IN COMPETITION**

If there are sufficient tee times available players may opt to play Not in Competition (NIC) at the back of the field in the ladies reserved times. Players wishing to do this should email the draw officer to be included in the sheet.

## **58. SERIES COMPETITIONS**

E.g. Charity Bowl, Daphne Tant, Turkey Trot. Where there is a tie for overall winner of the series, the highest individual scorecard for those players involved will be used to determine the winner. If there is still a tie the winner will be determined by countback on the tied cards. (Agreed at Committee Meeting January 2016)

## **59. NULL AND VOID**

Competitions may only be cancelled or declared null and void if:

- The course is closed due to adverse weather. Should thunder and lightning occur it is the player's responsibility to leave the course. If such events occur during a round the player should mark her ball and return to the clubhouse. Play can be resumed when the weather clears.
- The course is changed during the competition by green staff.
- There are insufficient numbers to take part.

The competition will not ordinarily be abandoned once it has begun except in exceptional circumstances. The decision will be taken by the Lady Captain, or Vice-Captain in conjunction with the committee and the club management.

## **60. CHANGES**

If there is to be any change to format of a trophy competition the donor of the trophy will be contacted wherever possible in order to be advised, and to seek agreement out of courtesy.

Any amendment or change to the Competitions Book must be agreed by the Ladies Committee and the date of change, as agreed in the minutes, noted in the Competitions Book.

## **61. MIXED COMPETITIONS**

3 Qualifying competitions must be played each year to qualify to play in mixed competitions. See entry forms and notices of the board in the changing room corridor.

## **62. GENERAL PLAY SCORES**

If a player intends to submit scores for casual rounds, they must sign in to a casual round on HDID or the PSI system BEFORE playing, and the score entered therein afterwards. (Congu ruling 2018) Amends agreed Committee meeting April 2022.
